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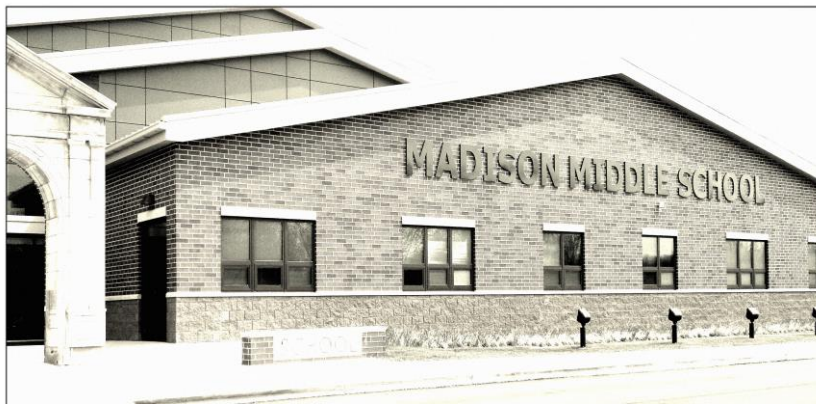

This letter is to provide you information about the College Credit Plus program. As per HB59, students in grades 7-12 will have the opportunity to take college level coursework. The goal of the legislation is to promote rigorous academic pursuits and provide options to college-ready students. Furthermore, College Credit Plus allows high school students to earn college credit and apply that credit toward their high school graduation requirements.

To participate in the program students will have to successfully be admitted to their college of interest. This would include a qualifying ACT score, grades, admission essay, an interview, or other requirements decided on by the college that the student is applying to. Parents will have to provide transportation for the student to the college to participate in the classes, or the accessibility to an electronic device if they participate in an online course. Currently, the district has a partnership with OSU-Mansfield, North Central State College, and Ashland University.

If you would like to learn more about this opportunity, there is an informational meeting on Monday, December 5th in the High School cafeteria at 7:00pm for parents of students who are going to be in grades 7-12 for the 2017-2018 school year. There will also be representatives from different colleges in the area to explain how to apply for admission to their institution.
